

T-MEC: Uniform Regulations

On June 03 of the current year, the Ministry of Economy (*Secretaría de Economía*) divulged that the negotiation of the Uniform Regulations for the Mexico, United States and Canada Treaty (T-MEC) have concluded and on the same day published the English version of the texts, for informative purposes, in its official website <https://www.gob.mx/t-mec/acciones-y-programas/textos-finales-de-las-reglamentacionesuniformes?state=published>.

It is important to mention that the English version of the texts will still be subject to a legal review and verification between the Parties in the English, Spanish and French languages for further accuracy, clarity and coherence.

Hereafter the titles of the published texts:

Part I: Uniform Regulations for Rules of Origin (RoO)

Uniform regulations regarding the interpretation, implementation and Administration of chapter 4 (origin norms) and provisions related with Chapter 6 (textile goods and clothes) of the agreement between the United States of America, Mexican United States and Canada.

Part II. Uniform Regulations for the procedures of origin (OP)

Uniform regulations about the interpretation, implementation and administration of Chapters 5 (procedures of origin), 6 (textile goods and clothes) and 7 (customs administration and commercial facilitation) of the agreement between the United States of America, Mexican United States and Canada.

The purpose of these Uniform Regulations is to provide practical and useful orientation for a better fulfillment of the Rules and Procedures of the new Commercial Treaty T-MEC.
